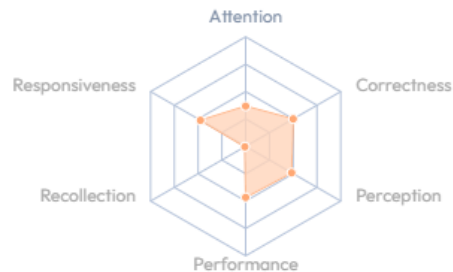

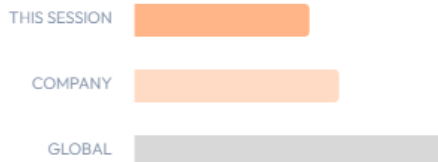

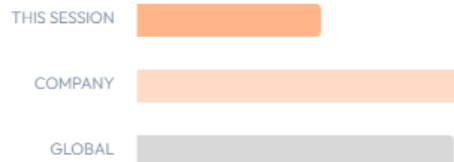

Progress Measured

Progress is measured in segments for each trainee, depending on the experience. Trainees generally experience a Discovery (prior knowledge) phase, along with Practice and Exam phases. A trainees playthrough is then mapped to each segment, highlighting decisions they did (or didn't) make, and where they went right and wrong.

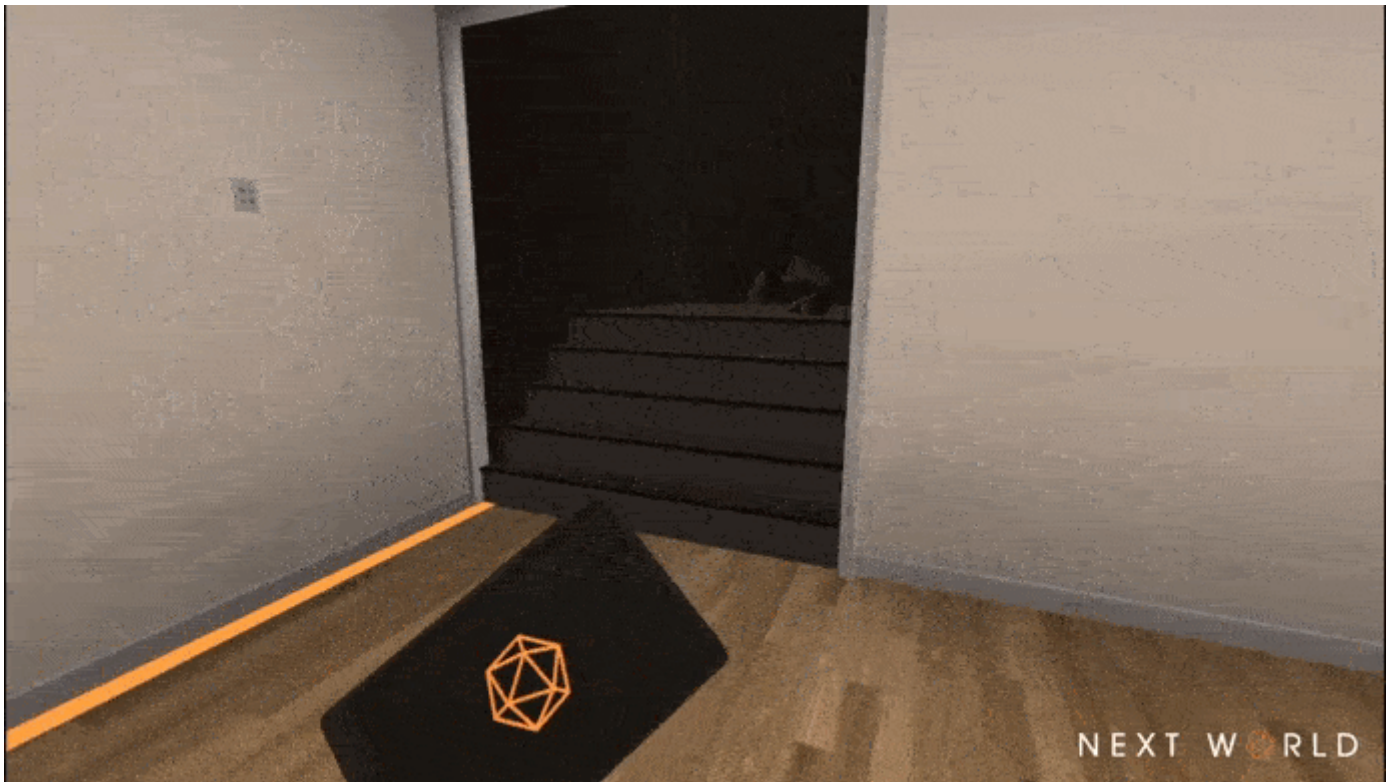
The exam section tests the trainee on their knowledge gained throughout their practice section.

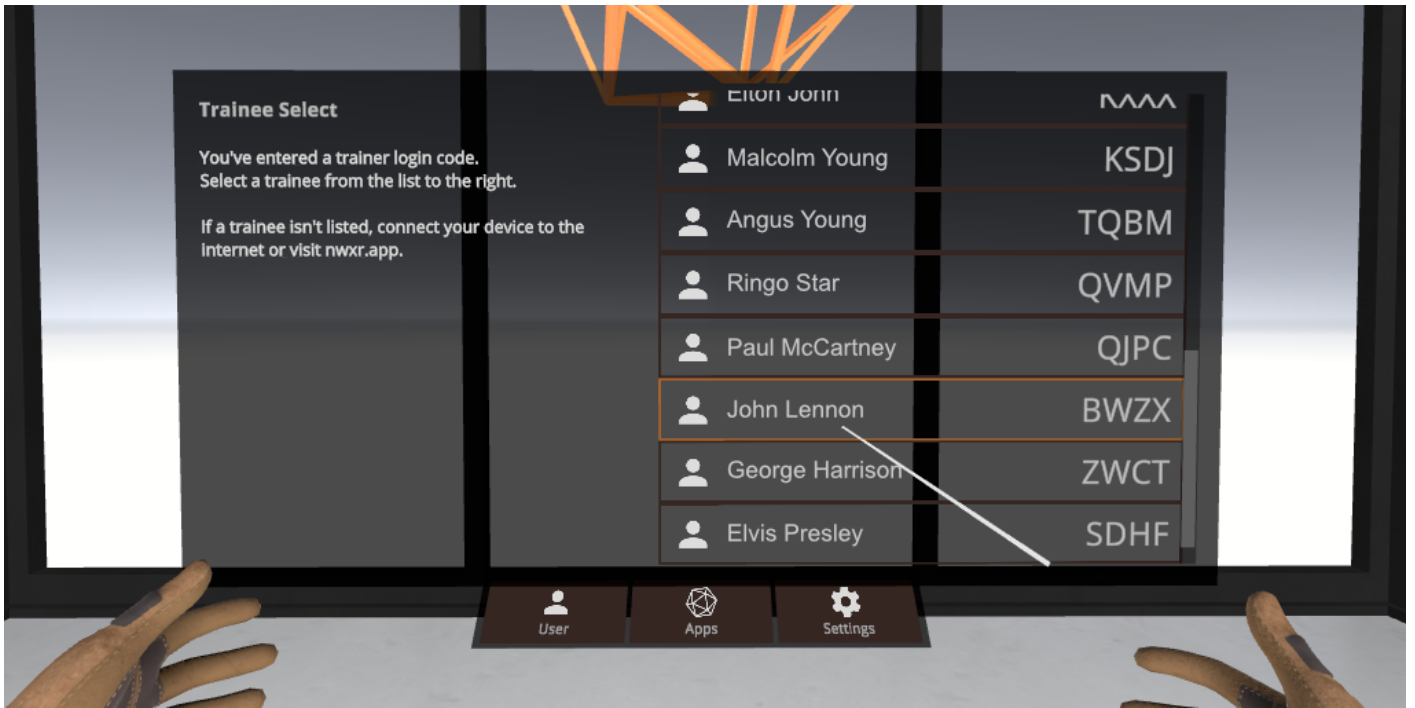
